

SPEAKER: This is contributing worldwide to problems of antibiotic resistance, where we actually see infections that we can't predictably treat with the antibiotics we have. And so there's no clear benefit to using these antibacterial soaps rather than regular soaps. And so if there's no clear benefit and also a real potential downside to it, it makes a lot of sense not to be using these products. In general, just good hand hygiene-- regular soap and water, also these alcohol hand sanitizers-- these are all very, very good. The use of the antibacterial soaps I usually generally steer away from, just because there's no clear benefit.
