

SPEAKER 1: No. I mean, it's remarkable that it's such a great safety profile. So I tell my patients with confidence that there is nothing to be concerned about from a safety perspective with these drugs. They don't cause muscle problems or joint problems the way that statins do.

They don't have any other concerns about, say, liver toxicity or other things that we sometimes may see occasionally with statins. And so they're very safe compound, very easy to use. The self-injection's easy. Every once in a while, there'll be an injection site reaction, but that's a minor problem.

So I feel confident that the safety profile is very good. And I expressed that to my patients.
