

SPEAKER 1: Some patients do better with photopheresis than others. We tend to select patients who are erythrodermic and with blood involvement, but there are some other factors which are usually associated with a good response to photopheresis. And these include within six months of having the diagnosis, a [INAUDIBLE] count less than 20%, and before chemotherapy treatment is being given. So if those patients fit into that category, their responses may be higher than 60%.
