

SPEAKER: One of the difficult challenges in this infection is the degree of mucus production, mucus plugging in these bronchiectatic airways. And these organisms love to hide in biofilms. And effectively, our antibiotics only can do so much as far as biofilm penetration. So it makes a lot of sense to use these mechanical measures with airway clearance to, in fact, get rid of as much biofilm as possible to make the drugs, therefore, more effective. We don't have statistical evidence on the likelihood of culture conversion with antibiotics versus antibiotics plus airway clearance. But we certainly advocate the use of that modality with antibiotic therapy.
