

SPEAKER 1: There are several recommendations on the management, diagnostic evaluation, and treatment of Fabry Disease. There are some pediatric recommendations from the United States. There are some other recommendations from Europe. And more recently we generated a document on the recommendations for the management and therapy of Fabry Disease, by a multinational cohort of authors, who are specialists in different organs affected by Fabry Disease. And in that we provide-- it is open access. It was published 2018. And we provide organ-by-organ descriptions of how the disease looks like, what are the diagnostic evaluation steps, and also we commend therapy. Both from the point-of-view of treating the underlying metabolic defect, but even more importantly, for centers where they do not have a multidisciplinary team.

We comment symptomatic therapy-- organ-by-organ systematic therapy. How to protect the kidneys, how to protect the heart, how to treat pain. This is a very important issue for patients. So a neurologist is specialized in pain management-- discuss all the available possibilities to manage pain. And so organ-by-organ and even in special situations, like pregnancy, like dialysis patients.
