

FREDERICK R LANE: For surgeons who don't use the Thunderbeat, I guess the thoughts I have are, if you're using a Harmonic Scalpel, I personally like this better, because I think it's a little quicker than the Harmonic Scalpel. And I think for the bigger vessels, especially a pedicle, especially in a patient with bigger hemorrhoids, it seals that pedicle better.

It seals that pedicle. It makes a more comfortable seal than with the Harmonic does. I'm just more comfortable with that pedicle sealing. I don't feel like I have to put a stitch in every one of those pedicles like I do sometimes with the Harmonic.
